PREVIOUS MINUTES and MATTERS ARISING:

Accepted. A membership flier is in production and will be available for the Teneriffe Festival and will be distributed in the neighbourhood by Cajj with the assistance of others. The new TPA sign was completed and displayed.

MEMBERSHIP & SUBSCRIPTIONS:

CORRESPONDENCE & MEDIA

- BCC Traffic Study. Teneriffe was completely ignored despite the TPA's submissions on the matter.
- BCC Recycling Initiative: Posters supplied by BCC for respective bin areas. Suggestion to contribute to BCC's "Teneriffe News"
- Cross-River Ferry: Facebook owner very happy to have us contribute on the subject re Pets on the Ferry.
- Regulated Parking Survey: Permits for individual streets rather than suburbs.

TENERIFFE FESTIVAL

- Roster setup was completed.
- The festival committee has relocated our stall to Ethel Street. This generated much discussion and it was decided Ben would contact the committee and request we return to our previous years' position.
- White Board suggestions were put forward for the public's comments as per previous years.

PERCENT FOR PUBLIC REALM

- Mr. Dean Brosnan of Neue Lighting presented his proposal for lighting the façade's of London woolstores. It was agreed that the proposal was high class and is backed by the TPA. This could only be good for Teneriffe and Brisbane should we be able to get this off the ground, financing being the biggest hurdle. It is hoped that council and government can see the benefits to Brisbane in terms of historical tourism and come on board with more than the current offer of 50%.

RUBBISH COLLECTION/CLEAN UP TENERIFFE

- Suggestion to get local coffee shops and council on board to contribute to rubbish collection by providing a 'free' coffee for each 'bucket' of rubbish collected. TPA could contribute one third of the cost, BCC another third and the coffee shop the remaining third. Michael Fritschi to approach Hemingway's to sound out the proposal.

- Discussion also on a proposed Clean Up Teneriffe Day in September, once again in conjunction with the local scouts.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed at 7.25pm.
